NEW The Department of Architecture at ETH Zurich offers a two-year Master's degree program in Landscape Architecture. Initiated by Prof. Teresa Galí-Izard, Prof. Christophe Girot, and Prof. Günther Vogt, it is the only such program in Switzerland.

The program offers an in-depth qualification in landscape architecture following a university Bachelor's degree in architecture. With this novel profile, graduates will open new fields of activity and research in landscape architecture. They will develop and implement projects at various scales from object design to conceptual planning. The key challenges in landscape design include regional transformation processes, climate adaptation and health, the built environment and historical contexts, as well as social phenomena such as demographic change. Additionally there are topics such as landscape regeneration and the integration of new infrastructures in the landscape.

This Master's program in Landscape Architecture focuses primarily on design studios, teaching students design and planning, materials and construction, natural sciences and humanities in an innovative way. Digital analysis, design and planning methods are an essential part of the education. The advantages of the program are: modular focus semesters, regular field trips, professional internship as well as the linking of subject-specific content and its integration in the design studios. The lessons are held in English and German and the program guarantees individual supervision.

Duration and volume

4 semesters + 6 months internship, 120 ECTS

Admission

Admission to the Master's degree program requires a Bachelor's degree in architecture from a university (3rd level institution) with at least 180 ECTS or equivalent. A motivation letter and a portfolio are required for the application.
